This month's presentation: Jamin York: Life and Journey Through The Himalayas, January 3rd at 7 pm.



Allow yourself to be drawn into a world steeped in cultural and historical tradition and journey through a land untouched by the modern world. Listen while Jamin York brings you closer to the distant land of the Himalayas through his stories of living and working on the Tibetan plateau.

In October of 2016, Sue DeArman, Karla Piecuch, and Nancy Meyer joined Jamin on a Tibetan journey that took them from Lhasa to Everest Base Camp, Shishapangma Base Camp, the shores of Lake Manasarovar, around the holy Mt. Kailash, and across the Tibetan plateau to the lost Guge Kingdom in far west Tibet.

Enjoy an evening hearing about this journey as well as his travels through nearly every town in Tibet, his treks across the Tibetan plateau, and exploration of large areas of Nepal, Ladakh, and Bhutan. Learn more about the obstacles and triumphs he has faced

in developing sustainable tourism for Himalayan people living in the Tibetan region and his work with community development projects in remote nomadic areas. Jamin will bring his stories to life through his breathtaking photos and will leave time for conversation and questions at the end of his presentation.

Jamin is the owner of Himalaya Journey, a company based here in Washington State that arranges treks, cultural, historical, and photography tours through the Himalayas. He is also the author of the popular Tibet travel website <u>The Land of Snows</u>. Jamin, from Olympia WA, lived full time in Tibet for 15 years and still leads 3 to 4 back to back journeys a year. He is regarded as an expert in Tibetan culture and history.

 your ability to participate in an activity, discuss the trip thoroughly with the sponsor, but the responsibility
 for your safety is yours. Each participant is responsible for his or her own comfort, safety and route
 finding. Always carry the 10 essentials!
- Please call the trip leader early with trip cancellations or requests. As a courtesy to the sponsor of the
 outing you are joining, please call with cancellations or requests at least two days in advance for singleday outings, and as soon as possible for overnight outings. This allows the sponsor time to make
 alternate plans should a trip need to be canceled or changed for any reason.
- Please leave pets at home when attending PWC outings unless the trip is specifically listed as welcoming them.

Carpool and Ride Sharing:

We strongly encourage carpooling and ride sharing to reduce impact to trailheads, minimize our environmental footprint, and reduce costs. Please be considerate of your drivers, including situations when you ride with different drivers in each direction. The amount you contribute to your driver should reflect the distance driven, the cost of gas, tolls, and any parking fees.
