Not beginning long distance hiking until age 60, Mary takes you on trail journeys to experience encounters with the beauty of wilderness from the Eastern ranges of the Appalachian Trail, the challenges of desert, snow, granite and thick forests of the Pacific Crest Trail, and the rugged and remote grandeur of the Continental Divide Trail.

Along the way you are introduced to the Trail Community. Hikers of many ages and walks of life labeled with colorful monikers called trail names and trail angels, planned and total surprises, grace her journey. Bear, moose, deer, coyotes, turkey vultures, hawks, eagles, owls, pronghorn, and endless supplies of squirrels and chipmunks share the world through which she walked.

Please be considerate of your drivers, including situations when you ride with different drivers in each direction. 
